7. Discussion and possible action to approve the Minutes from the August 21, 2023, Regular meeting.

8. Discussion and possible action to approve the Financial Report for August and September 2023 and disbursement to date, subject to audit.

GM Boniface presented financial reports for August and September 2023. First noted was reduction in water loss due to main line repairs. GM Boniface stated that Acoustic Leak Detection Services has been hired to detect further leaks within the system and expects water loss to reduce further once leaks are detected and repaired. FY23 ended September 30<sup>th</sup> with a loss of \$8,000 after contributions into capital improvements. Both water purchase and utility expenses were over budget for the year and water sales just over \$200,000.

Motion to approve August and September 2023 the financial reports and disbursements to date, subject to audit made by Director, John Bockhold and seconded by Sec./Treas., Dewitt Mayfield.

9. Discussion and possible action on adopting election procedures for 2024 annual membership meeting in accordance with the Texas Water Code, sections 67.0051 and 67.007.

General Manager, Boniface stated the procedures must be adopted as part of the election process in preparation for the 2024 annual membership meeting. These are the same procedures the Board approved last year and were developed by TRWA legal in accordance with Texas Water Codes.

Motion to approve the election procedures made by Director, John Bockhold and seconded by Sec./Treas., Dewitt Mayfield.

10.Discussion and possible action on bid tabulation and summary letter from MRB Group related to Pump Station 1 System Improvements project.

General Manager, Boniface presented bids. Bids presented are competitive but higher than expected due to project delays and inflation. Moffat WSC is facing a budget shortfall for the project of approximately \$961,000. GM Boniface recommends working with Engineer, Contractor, and TWDB to seek funding solutions and project cost reductions to alleviate this shortfall. Options can be presented at the next regular board meeting.

Motion to approve GM Boniface to coordinate funding solutions to present at the next meeting by Sec./Tres., Dewitt Mayfield and seconded by Director, John Bockhold.
